



Fireworks Display Requirements

The following are required for display fireworks in the Town of Hooksett per SAF-C 5000. This shall apply to all displays that include fireworks covered under 1.3G (Display Fireworks), 1.4 G (Consumer Fireworks), 1.4 S (Special Fireworks). NH Permissible fireworks are not required to meet these requirements.

- *Permit:*
 - *Permit must be obtained for any Display Fireworks on form DSSP 166*
 - *Only Licensed person from company may obtain the permit (shall have in his possession a certification card from Director of NH State Police)*
 - *Request for permit must be filed a minimum of 15 days in advance of the display*
- *Site Approval:*
 - *Prior to permit being approved, a site walk-thru shall be held with the permit requester and the Fire Chief or his designee at the proposed site*
 - *Minimum Distances:*
 - *50' from above ground electrical, or overhead obstructions*
 - *200' from nearest public way, or means of travel*
 - *200' from nearest building*
 - *250' from nearest tent or canvas structure*
 - *500' from nearest hospital, penal facility, or other health care or detention establishment*
 - *200' from audience for shells less than 10"*
 - *300' from audience for shells 10" or larger*
- *Display:*
 - *Licensed operator shall be on-site at all times (time fireworks arrive until display has been removed and site walk completed)*
 - *1st Light walk shall be completed the following morning and phone call to Fire Chief or his designee with findings **(SHALL BE COMPLETED)***
 - *Display and transport vehicle subject to inspection*
 - *Preload inspection will be completed by Fire Chief or his designee*
 - *Pre fire inspection will be completed by Fire Chief or his designee*
 - *Vehicle inspection will be completed by Fire Chief or his designee*
- *All requirements set forth in SAF-C 5000 shall be followed at all times*
